
#### Moleben in honour of the Mother of God

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.



**Priest:** For the kingdom, the power and the glory are Yours, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever.






#### Invocations

**Priest:** Rejoice, Most holy virgin Mary, ever-merciful Mother of God, and save all those who place their trust in you.



**Priest:** Rejoice, Mary, Canopy more boundless than the heavens and save all those who place their trust in you.













**Priest:** Bowing our heads in all humility, let us pray to the Lord.






