SOROKOUSTY SERVICES – ALL SOULS SATURDAYS

Sorokousty Services (All Souls Saturday) will be celebrated this year on **February 15th, March 7th, March 14th, March 21st, and May 30th**.

The word "Sorokousty" literally means "forty mouths" (*sorok* = *forty*; *ust* = *mouth*). Originally, this was a prayer service offered by forty mouths or by forty priests especially in Lenten time.

Sorokousty or All Souls Saturday's services have been celebrated for the deceased by holding Liturgies, panakydas or parastas for them in five Saturdays.

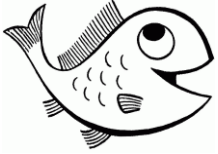

We Pray for Our Family



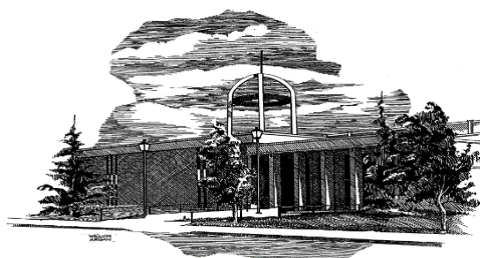
