# SIXTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST Holy Fathers of the First Six Councils

**TROPAR (Tone 5):** Let us the faithful acclaim and worship the word, co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit, and born of the Virgin for our salvation. For He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh, to suffer death and to raise the dead by His glorious resurrection.

Glory be to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, now and forever and ever. Amen!

**KONDAK (Tone 5):** You, my Savior, descended to Hades, and as the Almighty, You shattered its gates. With Yourself You, as the Creator, raised the dead and shattered the sting of death, and delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of Mankind. And so we cry out: "Save us, O Lord."

**PROKIMEN (Tone 5):** You, O Lord, will guard us and will keep us from this generation and for ever. Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer left a just man.

**EPISTLE:** A reading from the Epistle to the Hebrews (13:7-16)

**Brothers and Sisters!** Remember your leaders who spoke the word of God to you; consider how their lives ended, and imitate their faith. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teaching. It is good to have our hearts strengthened by the grace of God and not by foods which are useless to those who take them as a standard for living. We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat. The bodies of the animals whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest as a sin offering are burned outside the camp. Therefore, Jesus died outside the gate, to sanctify the people by his own blood. Let us go to him outside the camp, bearing the insult which he bore. For here we have no lasting city, we are seeking one which is to come. Through him let us continually offer God a sacrifice of praise, that is, the fruit of lips which acknowledge his name. Do not neglect good deeds and generosity, God is pleased by sacrifices of that kind.

**ALLELUIA VERSES:** Your mercies, O Lord, I will sing for ever; from generation to generation I will announce Your truth with my mouth.

For You have said: Mercy shall be built up for ever; in the heavens Your truth shall be prepared.

#### **GOSPEL:** John 17:1-13

At that time Jesus looked up to heaven and said: "Father, the hour has come! Give glory to your Son that your Son may give glory to you, inasmuch as you have given him authority over all mankind, that he may bestow eternal life on those you gave him. Eternal life is this, to know you, the only true God, and him whom you have sent, Jesus Christ. I have given you glory on earth by finishing the work you gave me to do. Do you now, Father, give me glory at your side, a glory I had with you before the world began. I have made your name known to those you gave me out of the world. These men you gave me were yours; they have kept your word. Now they realize that all that you gave me comes from you. I entrusted to them the message you entrusted to me. They have known that in truth I came from you, they have believed it was you who sent me. For these I pray – not for the world but for these you have given me, for they are really yours. Just as all that belongs to me is yours, so all that belongs to you is mine. It is in them that I have been glorified. I am in the world no more, but these are in the world as I come to you. O Father most holy, protect them with your name which you have given me, that they may be one, even as we are one. As long as I was with them, I guarded them with your name which you gave me. I kept careful watch, and not one of them was lost, none but him who was destined to be lost – in fulfillment of Scripture. Now, however, I come to you; I say all this while I am still in the world that they may share my joy completely.

Vatican Confirms Papal Visit to Canada Program – July 24 – 29, 2022 A Visit of Healing, Hope & Reconciliation

The Vatican has released additional details regarding the Papal Visit to Canada, July 24-29, 2022. The

Pope's visit will provide an opportunity for him to listen and dialogue with Indigenous Peoples, to express his heartfelt closeness and to address the impact of residential schools in Canada. The papal visit will also provide an opportunity for the shepherd of the world's 1.2 billion Catholics to connect with the Catholic community in Canada.

The Holy Father will travel within Alberta (based in Edmonton) from July 24-27, followed by a visit to Quebec City and Ste. Anne-de-Beaupré, July 27-29. Pope Francis will visit Iqaluit, Nunavut the afternoon of July 29 before returning to Rome.

Drawing on the theme, "Walking Together", the Holy Father's journey of reconciliation, healing and hope includes visits to a former residential school, Indigenous pilgrimage sites, two public Masses and a mix of

private and public events. There will be tickets available (free) for a limited number of events, all of which will be broadcast and accessible via livestream.



#### SIXTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST – ICON OF CHRIST THE LIFGIVER



**DO ALL IN THE NAME OF THE LORD:** There will indeed be nothing of evil, nothing impure, in our invoking the sacred name. If you eat, if you drink, should you marry, if you set out on a journey, do all in the name of Jesus, that is, calling upon him to help you. And having in all that you do invoked him, then apply yourself to the thing in hand. Should you wish to speak concerning any business, do this beforehand. For this reason do we also place the name of the Lord at the head of our epistles. Wherever there is the Lord's name, everything will be well. For if the names of the consuls are affixed to documents, to insure that they are authentic, how much more the name of Jesus.

Again, the apostle likewise means to say and do everything as is right and fitting in relation to God. Do you eat? Offer thanks to God, before and after. Are you going out among people? Wherever the name of the Lord is set up, all things prosper. If it has power to drive away demons, if it can banish illness, much more will it aid your own actions.

Recall how Abraham sent his servant in the name of God. And, David in the name of the Lord slew Goliath; great and wonderful is the name of the Lord! They who do this have God for their helper; without whom they can do nothing.
