FOURTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

TROPAR (Tone 5): Let us the faithful acclaim and worship the Word, co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit, and born of the Virgin for our salvation. For He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh, to suffer death and to raise the dead* by His glorious resurrection.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen!

KONDAK (Tone 5): You, my Savior, descended to Hades, and as the Almighty, You shattered its gates. With Yourself You, as the Creator, raised the dead and shattered the sting of death, and delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of Mankind. And so we cry out: "Save us, O Lord."

PROKIMEN (Tone 5): You, O Lord, will guard us and will keep us from this generation, and forever.

Verse: Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer left a just man.

EPISTLE: A reading from the Second Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Corinthians (1: 21-2:4)

Brothers and Sisters! God is the one who firmly establishes us along with you in Christ; it is he who anointed us and has sealed us, thereby depositing the first payment, the Spirit, in our hearts. I call on God as my witness that it was out of consideration for you that I did not come to Corinth again. Domineering over your faith is not my purpose. I prefer to work with you toward your happiness. As regards faith, you are standing firm. I did decide, however, not to visit you again in painful circumstances. For if I cause you pain, who can make me happy again but the ones I grieved? I wrote as I did so that when I come I may not be saddened by those who should rejoice my heart. I know you all well enough to be convinced that my happiness is yours. That is why I wrote you in great sorrow and anguish, with copious tears -- not to make you sad but to help you realize the great love I bear you.

ALLELUIA VERSES: *Your mercies, O Lord, I will sing forever; from generation to generation I will announce Your truth with my mouth.*

For You have said: Mercy shall be built up for ever; in the heavens Your truth shall be prepared.

GOSPEL: Matthew 22: 1-14

The Lord told this parable: "The reign of God may be likened to a king who gave a wedding banquet for his son. He dispatched his servants to summon the invited guests to the wedding, but they refused to come. A second time he sent other servants, saying: 'Tell those who were invited, See, I have my dinner prepared! My bullocks and corn-fed cattle are killed; everything is ready. Come to the feast.' Some ignored the invitation and went their way, one to his farm, another to his business. The rest laid hold of his servants, insulted them, and killed them. At this the king grew furious and sent his army to destroy those murderers and burn their city. Then he said to his servants: 'The banquet is ready, but those who were invited were unfit to come. That is why you must go out into the byroads and invite to the wedding anyone you come upon.' The servants then went out into the byroads and rounded up everyone they met, bad as well as good. This filled the wedding hall with banqueters. When the king came in to meet the guests, however, he caught sight of a man not properly dressed for a wedding feast. 'My friend,' he said, 'how is it you came in here not properly dressed?' The man had nothing to say. The king then said to the attendants, 'Bind him hand and foot and throw him out into the night to wail and grind his teeth.' The invited are many, the elect are few.

2. All emails I always start with a (seasonal) Christian Ukrainian Catholic Greetings or initials of these greeting which are well known to all Ukrainian Catholics.
3. I never ask favors like to manage discreetly things for me while I am in meetings, transfer money for gas, grocery or similar via emails.
4. When you are not sure if an email comes from me, please call me by phone.

2023 ANNUAL EPARCHIAL APPEAL

"Let Us Share the Gifts that We have been Given."



The 2023 Annual Eparchial Appeal initiative is now complete. The Foundation would like to say a huge **THANK YOU** to all the Parish Families who so generously contributed to this year's Annual Eparchial Appeal. We also want to say a **HUGE THANK YOU** to the many, many Parish Families who continue to contribute year after year to the Annual Eparchial Appeal. For this we are extremely grateful. Certainly, our success would not have been possible if it were not for the support, hard work, effort, and commitment to this Annual Eparchial Appeal by many people.

The total funds raised in the 2023 Annual Eparchial Appeal was \$113,431.00. The amount rebated to Parishes that exceeded their goal totaled \$795.00. After all the expenses incurred in conducting the Annual Eparchial Appeal have been paid and the allocation to the Bishop Roborecki Foundation made in the amount of \$8,763.60, the Eparchy will receive \$78,872.40.

The initiatives determined to be funded by the 2023 Annual Eparchial Appeal included the following:

- Ukrainian Catholic Religious Education Centre
- Eparchial Communications Office
- St. Matthew's Clergy Society
- Bishop Roborecki Foundation
- Chancery Support

The funds raised from the 2023 Annual Eparchial Appeal will be allocated by the Finance Officer to each initiative listed above based on the financial need of each initiative except for the amount allocated to the Bishop Roborecki Foundation.

In 2023, the participation rate of the Parish Families in the Eparchy who contributed to the Annual Eparchial Appeal remained at 20% which was the same participation rate in 2022. The highest participation rate occurred in 2015 when 33% of the Parish Families supported the Annual Eparchial Appeal. The lowest participation rate occurred in 2022 and 2023 at 20%.

The number of Parish Families who supported in the 2023 Annual Eparchial Appeal was 460 out of the total number of Parish Families in the Eparchy which is 2,320.

The average donation per Parish Family who donated to the 2023 Annual Eparchial Appeal was \$246.59. However, the average taking into consideration all the Parish Families in the Eparchy is \$48.89.

Two Parishes exceeded their Eparchial Goal and received a total rebate of \$795.00 were St. Nicholas Parish, Uhryniw (\$607.50) and St. Micheal's Parish, Alvena (\$187.50).

It is our hope that the participation numbers of the number of Parish Families contributing to the Annual Eparchial Appeal will increase and grow in the 2024 Annual Eparchial Appeal. We are hopeful that more Parishioners will see the important significance that their donation will make in the growth and continuance of our Ukrainian Catholic Church and Faith in Saskatchewan.

Thank you, again, for your generous support, and we hope that we can call on you again to be just as abundant, both in time and talent, during the 2024 Annual Eparchial Appeal. We will continue to stand together in faith and hope for our Church.
