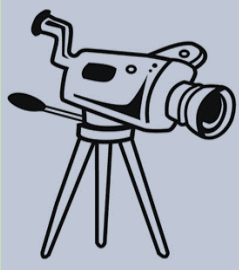

**EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST**

**- Protection of the Mother Of God**

**TROPAR (Tone 1):** Though the stone was sealed by the Jews and soldiers guarded Your most pure body, You arose, O Savior, on the third day, and gave life to the world. And so the heavenly powers cried out to You, O Giver of life: Glory to Your resurrection, O Christ! Glory to Your kingdom! Glory to Your saving plan, O only Lover of Mankind.

**FEAST DAY TROPAR (Tone 4):** Protected by your coming, O Mother of God, the faithful people solemnly celebrate today; and gazing upon your immaculate image, they humbly say: “Watch over us with your noble protection and deliver us from all evil, by asking your Son, Christ our God, to save our souls.”

*Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen!*

**FEAST DAY KONDAK (Tone 3):** Today, the Virgin is present in the Church, and with the armies of saints invisibly prays to God for us. The angels worship with the archangels, and the apostles rejoice with the prophets, because in our behalf, the Mother of God prays to the eternal God.

**PROKIMEN (Tone 3):** My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit has rejoiced in God my Saviour.

*Verse: Because He has regarded the humility of His handmaid; for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed.*

**EPISTLE:** A reading from the Second Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Corinthians (9: 6-11)

Brothers and Sisters! He who sows sparingly will reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will reap bountifully. Everyone must give according to what he has inwardly decided; not sadly, not grudgingly, for God loves a cheerful giver. God can multiply his favors among you so that you may always have enough of everything and even a surplus for good works, as it is written: “He scattered abroad and gave to the poor, his justice endures forever.” He who supplies seed for the sower and bread for the eater will provide in abundance; he will multiply the seed you sow and increase your generous yield. In every way your liberality is enriched; through us it results in thanks offered to God.

**ALLELUIA VERSES:** *Hear, O daughter, and see, and incline your ear.*

*The rich among the people shall entreat your countenance.*

## GOSPEL: Luke 5: 1-11

At that time as he stood by the Lake of Gennesaret, and the crowd pressed in on him to hear the word of God, he saw two boats moored by the side of the lake; the fishermen had disembarked and were washing their nets. He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to pull out a short distance from the shore; then, remaining seated, he continued to teach the crowds from the boat. When he had finished speaking he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch." Simon answered, "Master, we have been hard at it all night long and have caught nothing; but if you say so, I will lower the nets." Upon doing this they caught such a great number of fish that their nets were at the breaking point. They signaled to their mates in the other boat to come and help them. These came, and together they filled the two boats until they nearly sank. At the sight of this, Simon Peter fell at the knees of Jesus saying, "Leave me, Lord. I am a sinful man." For indeed, amazement at the catch they had made seized him and all his shipmates, as well as James and John, Zedede's sons, who were partners with Simon. Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid. From now on you will be catching men." With that they brought their boats to land, left everything, and became his followers.

**INSTEAD OF "It Is Truly Right...":** O my soul, extol the greatness of the protection of the ever-Virgin Mother of God. Let everyone on earth dance for joy in spirit. Let the heavenly ranks celebrate in honor of the sacred feast. O Mother of God, let them cry: "Rejoice, ever-blessed Mother of God and ever-Virgin."

**COMMUNION HYMN:** Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest. I will take the chalice of salvation; and I will call upon the name of the Lord. Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!

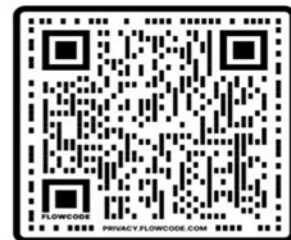

## ***LIFE WITHOUT GOD***

If we were to take "Christ out of the word "Christian" nothing of meaning would be left. With the three letters "ian" we can arrange the letters to have the meaning: "I am nothing." Isn't it true what Jesus said, "Without me you can do nothing" (John 15:5).

Apart from Christ we are nothing and can do nothing. All things that we value, all conditions necessary for happiness depend upon God.

Without God there would be no conscience, no morality that incites us to do good and avoid evil. Only where there is faith, belief in God, will the condition of people rest on a firm foundation. Only where people are ruled by God, who has set up limits of behavior for our own good, can there be equity and equality.

Where people do not obey the law of legitimate authority, we have the law of the jungle. Without law neither life nor property are safe. Without God and His law there would not be enough jails, police and legal penalties to deter the threat of death and crime. Life would be a living hell.

Without God greed, sensuality and tyranny would enslave everyone. Conflict among all and against all would be the inevitable result. The weak would be oppressed by the more powerful. Peace on earth would be impossible.

Psalms 119 gives us a taste of happiness with God. "They are happy whose life is blameless, who walk in the law of the Lord. Happy are they who observe His decrees, who seek Him with all their hearts ... "
