THIRD ANTIPHON: Regular 3rd antiphon...(Page 25) with the following refrain:

Son of God, transfigured on the mountain, save us who sing to you: Alleluia

TROPAR (Tone 8): You came down from on high, O Merciful One, and accepted three days of burial to free us from our sufferings. O Lord, our life and our resurrection, glory be to You.

TROPAR OF THE FEAST (Tone 7): You were transfigured on the mountain, O Christ our God, revealing as much of your glory to your disciples as they could behold. Through the prayers of the Mother of God, let your everlasting light also shine upon us sinners. O Giver of Light, glory be to You!

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen!

**EPISTLE:** A reading from the First Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Corinthians. (3: 9-17)

Brothers and Sisters! We are God's co-workers; while you are his cultivation, his building. Thanks to the favor God showed me I laid a foundation as a wise master builder might do, and now someone else is building upon it. Everyone, however, must be careful how he builds. No one can lay a foundation other than the one that has been laid, namely Jesus Christ. If different ones build on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay or straw, the work of each will be made clear. The Day will disclose it. That day will make its appearance with fire, and fire will test the quality of each man's work. If the building a man has raised on this foundation still stands, he will receive his recompense; if a man's building burns, he will suffer loss. He himself will be saved, but only as one fleeing through fire. Are you not aware that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, and you are that temple.

ALLELUIA VERSES: Come, let us rejoice in the Lord; let us acclaim God our Savior.

Verse: Let us come before His countenance with praise and acclaim Him with psalms.

**GOSPEL: Matthew (14: 22-34)** 

At that time while dismissing the crowds, Jesus insisted that his disciples get into the boat and precede him to the other side. When he had sent them away, he went up on the mountain by himself to pray, remaining there alone as evening drew on. Meanwhile the boat, already several hundred yards out from shore, was being tossed about in the waves, raised by strong head winds. At about three in the morning, he came walking toward them on the lake. When the disciples saw him walking on the water, they were terrified. "It is a ghost!" they said, and in their fear they began to cry out. Jesus hastened to reassure them: "Get hold of yourselves! It is I. Do not be afraid!" Peter spoke up and said, "Lord, if it is really you, tell me to come to you across the water." "Come!" he said. So Peter got out of the boat and began to walk on the water, moving toward Jesus. But when he perceived how strong the wind was, becoming frightened, he began to sink and cried out, "Lord, save me!" Jesus at once stretched out his hand and caught him. "How little faith you have," he exclaimed. "Why did you falter?" Once they had climbed into the boat, the wind died down. Those who were in the boat showed him reverence,

declaring, "Beyond doubt you are the Son of God." After making the crossing they reached the shore at Gennesaret.

INSTEAD OF "It Is Truly Right..." O my soul, extol the Lord\* transfigured on Mount Tabor. You gave birth without blemish; for it was God who came forth from your womb, appearing in the flesh upon the earth and dwelling among us. Therefore, O Mother of God, we extol you.

COMMUNION HYMN: Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest. O Lord, in the light of your countenance, we walk; at your name we rejoice all the day. Alleluia! Alleluia!







The Ukrainian Program will continue with its delivery of the program in the evenings. RCSD does not pay for the transportation costs. The Ukrainian Program will continue to be held at St. Matthew School.

The program will have a two-prong approach to delivery, online instruction and information as well as face-to-face instruction. The program will run on Wednesday and Thursday evenings at St. Matthew School. The Ukrainian program will begin on September 10 & 11, 2025.

Wednesday -4:30 - 6:30 p.m. Thursday -6:00 - 8:00 p.m.

We are allowing parents to bring their children on either of those evenings. Grades 1-4 will be with Mrs. Kohuch and grades 5-8 will be with Mrs. Zwarych. We will no longer be using the day system since that no longer applies, as our classes will be after school. Therefore, parents can bring their students on either of those days when it works best for their schedule. We are trying to be as flexible as we can with our delivery model.

#### **OUR PARKING LOT IS BROKEN!!!**

We are sure you have all noticed, our parking lot is falling apart and in desperate need of repair. After a lot of searching for a contractor to come and have a look at it, we received a quote from only one contractor who was interested in such a small job. Parish Council has approved proceeding with this contractor to repair the parking lot in the spring of 2025 at a cost of between \$70,000 and \$75,000, depending on prices in the spring. This includes removal of the existing pavement and cement, and replacement of any base material as required, and in the installation of speed bumps to slow down any through traffic to Huda School.





#### THE PROCESSION OF THE VENERABLE WOOD OF THE LIFE-CREATING CROSS OF THE LORD

The history of this feast begins in Constantinople. Because of the illnesses that occur in August, it was customary, in former times, to carry the relic of the Venerable Wood of the Cross through the streets and squares for the sanctification of the city, and for relief from sickness. On the eve (July 31), the relic was taken out of the imperial treasury, and laid upon the altar of the Great Church of Hagia Sophia. On August 1st, it was solemnly placed in the middle of the Great Church for the faithful to venerate. The relic was then taken in procession daily throughout the city, offering it to the people to venerate until the Feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos (August 15), when it was returned again to the imperial treasury.
